

**DOWNTOWN DOVER PARTNERSHIP
STEERING COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATIONS OF MAYOR CARLETON E. CAREY, SR.**

The Board of Directors shall consist of fifteen (15) directors, appointed from two (2) categories.

First Category. Six (6) individuals, either elected or appointed, from within the government of the City of Dover or State government. These individuals shall include the City Manager, the City Planner, members of City Council and one representative from state government. Individuals in the first category shall be nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council and will serve on the Board at the pleasure of the Mayor and Council. Vacancies in this category will be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council. Individuals in the first category shall remain as Board Members so long as deemed appropriate by the Mayor and City Council, and so long as they continue to be either elected or appointed officials within the government of the City of Dover. The individuals in the second category will be nominated, by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. Vacancies in this category will be nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council.

Second Category. Nine (9) individuals from the private sector with strong ties and commitment to revitalization of the downtown Dover area; these individuals should not now hold full-time elected or appointed public office. These individuals must include a resident of the downtown Dover area or an adjoining neighborhood, a downtown cultural arts representative, a downtown business owner, a downtown retailer, a real estate professional whose practice includes the downtown Dover area, a financial services professional whose practice includes the downtown Dover area, the chief executive officer of Bayhealth or his/her designee, and the president of Wesley College or his/her designee. Individuals in the second category shall serve a term of three (3) years. These members shall be eligible for reappointment to the Board. For the initial Board of Directors only, the individuals in the second category shall be divided into three classes of three individuals. The first class shall serve a term of one (1) year. The second class shall serve a term of two (2) years. The third class shall serve a term of three (3) years, after which each class will all serve three year terms.
